

Messiah versus Christ.

It is necessary to clarify this point because there is much confusion in the Human Being about what a Christ is and what a Messiah is. And this confusion is blatantly intentional.

Many cultures that persist to this day have the myth that they were founded by the Gods of the Sun. And here the two concepts are already mixed. The culture that most clearly reflects this myth is the Toltec, of which hardly anything remains, but its myths are reflected in its ruins.

The myth of the Feathered Serpent, of the Toltec culture, establishes the fact that the gods become men, inhabit among us, and sacrifice themselves to provide 1000 or 2000 more years of life to humanity, until the next Feathered Serpent emerges. That is, the Feathered Serpent revitalizes humanity giving it hope to continue, with a frequency of approximately every 1000 or 2000 years.

What is happening, since the Neolithic and getting lost in the Paleolithic, is that with this frequency a Christ arises, that is, a man who tries to change the world, who tries to get Humanity out of its horrible crime of refuse to live with everything involved in it, with all the horror that Humanity takes on. This man is lynched for his audacity and for his foolishness, since it is useless before the Pact with the Death of the Human Being, that he did not discover. Humanity turns all its anger on him. Now, the meaning of him is changed, and he becomes a Messiah.

And what is a Messiah? A Messiah is a great military political leader who achieves total victory for his people. Take a big change! The Christ does not fight, he preaches peace, collaboration and respect, and he is attributed, after lynching him,

the ability to feed the struggle of his people, when he had no people, but spoke to all The humanity.

Here we have the origin of the myth of the Gods of the Sun, deeply rooted and with many variations, which fuels the human struggle. See, for example, the myth of Atlantis, which was recounted for millennia in vast areas around Ancient Egypt. It evolved as an oral legend, each narrator introduced his or her impromptu, until it reached the ears of Platon, a great criminal against humanity, he liked it and wrote it.

And what do the myths of Atlantis and others say? Well, there was a civilization of giants, very technologically advanced, who dominated the world, and from which derive the calls to the Final Victory. This is what the Nazis understood, and Hitler was their Messiah, but they weren't the only ones. The Jews also wait for their Messiah to give them the Final Victory. Each and every one of the excluding human groups awaits their Messiah and his Victory.

In every opportunity that Humanity has to get out of its criminality, there is a trap set by Humanity, and the Christs fall into this trap. They try to change the world and become defenders of the fight, feeding human criminality for 1000 or 2000 years.

Yes, okay, the Messiahs provide victory for 1000 years (millennialism), if they win, but what does he or she win at the End of the World?

The prize for the winner is death. In the pyramid of the Feathered Serpent, in Teotihuacan, Mexico, the tomb of God is represented. Through a tunnel that starts from the front, you access a narrow and roughly excavated chamber under the center of the pyramid. There is no comfort, just where to sit. Here God would enter once the whole planet died, and he or she would die little by

little of hunger in total darkness, a frightening agony, while he or she would realize what has happened in Humanity, without the possibility of correction. How awful.

However, at the End of the World in which we find ourselves, not one more Christ appears who also falls into the trap, but the Antichrist appears, something very different, because the Antichrist, who is me, discovers the entire human cake, from the fact that no one believes himself or herself immortal until the Pact with Death, so he does not fall into any of the traps set by Humanity. In this way, the Antichrist will not become Messiah, and he will not win any fight. As for the emergence of a Messiah directly, well, there are a few opting for the Throne, we all know who they are.
